Whereas, January 22, 2018 was the 100th anniversary of independent Ukrainian statehood proclaimed by the Ukrainian Central Rada in 1918, before being dominated by the Soviet Union; and

Whereas, After the breakup of the Soviet Union, the Parliament of Ukraine formally declared an independent Ukrainian state on August 24, 1991; and



Whereas, Ukrainian Independence Day brings to mind the value of the freedoms we enjoy and hold dear as New Mexicans and citizens of the United States; and


Now, Therefore, I, Timothy M. Keller, Mayor of the City of Albuquerque, do hereby proclaim, August 2nd, 2018, as:
